




### TO OPT-OUT OF THE GSA HEALTH & DENTAL PLAN:

The FALL term enrolled students ONLY: <u>Opt-out January 1 - 30, 2024</u> To opt-out during **WINTER TERM** newly enrolled graduate students <u>ONLY</u> are asked to email <u>health@brockgsa.ca</u> to provide valid proof of their alternate, comparable and continuous Canadian Health & Dental Benefits coverage with the following:

- Image of Benefits Card showing Student's name
- Insurance Provider's Name, Policy & Plan number
- Employer's name, if the Health & Dental Benefits Plan is provided by an employer

Detailed listing of benefits provided to ensure Canadian plan is comparable and continuous through to August 31st, 2024.
 NOTE: OHIP/UHIP is <u>NOT</u> considered an eligible alternate plan

### **Prescription Drug Coverage**

### Drug Coverage – 50% - 90% Coverage

Overall Drug Maximum of \$2,500 per participant per benefit year. The termination age for Drug Coverage for the Brock GSA Health & Dental benefits is 80.



### This includes the DrugSmart Pharmacy across from Campus

90% Coverage Generic Drugs 70% Coverage Brand Drugs Dispensing Fee: 100% of any amount up to \$7

#### All Other Pharmacies

 80% Coverage
 Generic Drugs

 50% Coverage
 Brand Drugs

 Dispensing Fee: 100% of any amount up to \$5

### Mandatory Generic Product Select

- Brand name drugs will be covered up to the amounts listed above up to the cost of the lowest-priced generic equivalent.
- Only those drugs which legally require a prescription and are eligible under the benefits will be covered.

### Drug Benefit also Includes:

- Contraceptives (incl oral, IUD's, IUS's) {One/5 benefit years}
- Diabetic Supplies (test strips & needles, glucometers may be covered under Extended Health)
- CNS Stimulants\* (80% Coverage, \$500/benefit year)
- Hepatitis C Medications (\$1,500/lifetime)
- Biologic Agents (\$1,000/benefit year)
- Anti-Obesity Drugs, Erectile Dysfunction Drugs, Fertility Treatment, Smoking Cessation Medications with physician's prescription (\$500 combined/lifetime on a cost reimbursement basis)



### **Dental Coverage**

### Dental Coverage - 25% - 70% Coverage

The termination age for Dental coverage for the Brock GSA Health & Dental benefits is 80.

Pre-Determination: It is strongly recommended to obtain a pre-determination for extensive dental procedures to prevent unexpected costs. Have your dentist send a pre-determination along with your name and Student ID to Medavie Blue Cross<sup>TM</sup> at fax: 506-867-4651.

Students can check to see if the dental code on their pre-determination is eligible under the benefits. Login to the <u>Blue Cross Member Portal</u> to find out! Note that this does not say how much is eligible, just if the code itself is eligible under your benefits.

Annual combined maximum of \$800.00/year/insured Reimbursement based on Current Dental Fee Guide. Note that specialist fees will be paid at General Practitioner rates.

#### Examinations (70%)

Complete oral examination (once every 5 years) / Limited & Recall examination (once every 12 months)

#### Radiographs (70%)

Complete series Periapical or Panoramic (once every 5 years) / Bitewing (once every 12 months)

### Preventative Services (70%)

Dental polishing (1, 15-minute unit every 12 months) / Scaling (2, 15-minute units every 12 months)

### Minor Restorative (50%)

Fillings

#### Extractions (25%) Includes wisdom tooth extractions

Anesthesia (50%) When in conjunction with surgical services

### Other Dental Coverage (50%)

Endodontic / Periodontics / Denture Services

### Practitioner Coverage – 100% Coverage

The termination age for Extended Health Coverage for the Brock GSA Health & Dental benefits is 80.

#### Max \$40/visit up to \$520 combined per benefit year:

- Chiropractor
- Naturopath
- Speech Therapist
- Physiotherapist
- Registered Massage Therapist\*

\*Prescription required for first [RMT] claim each new policy year, if prescription is less than 12 months from date of issue, it can be used in subsequent policy years.

#### Max \$1000 combined per benefit year, no per visit max:

- Psychologist\*\*
- Psychotherapist\*\*
- Social Worker (MSW)\*\*

\*\*Clinical Counsellors and other mental health practitioners who do not meet the above criteria will not be considered eligible for coverage under the benefits. \*\*Psychotherapists must be in good standing with the college in their province, as well as registered as a provider with Medavie Blue Cross and be issued a provider number.

### Other Medical Coverage- 100% Coverage

Coverage is to maximum indicated, unless otherwise stated:

- Orthotic Appliances or Orthopedic Shoes (1 pair every 3 years)\*\*\*
- Medical Equipment & Supplies (Reasonable & Customary)\*\*\*\*\*\*\*
- Ambulance to Nearest Treating Hospital (\$1,000/benefit year Reasonable & Customary)

\*\*\*Prescribed by a medical doctor, an orthopedic surgeon or podiatrist \*\*\*\*For a full listing of eligible expenses, please see the benefit booklet



### Vision Coverage – 100% Coverage

The termination age for Vision Coverage for the Brock GSA Health & Dental benefits is 80.

- · Eye Examinations 1 standard exam every 24 months (reasonable & customary)
- · Frames, Lenses & Contact Lenses \$250 every 24 months

This coverage excludes expenses incurred for non-corrective sunglasses and safety glasses. Please make sure to include your prescription (no more than 2 years old) along with your receipt when submitting claims for reimbursement.

Frames, Lenses and Contact Lenses must be purchased from a Canadian provider to be considered eligible under the benefits.


Frames are only eligible if purchased in conjunction with prescription lenses.

Lasik or Laser Eye Surgery are NOT covered under the benefits.

### What is the Brock GSA Health & Dental Benefits Plan? Why do I have it?

The Brock GSA Health & Dental plan is a comprehensive benefits plan offered through Student VIP & Medavie Blue Cross™ for Brock University Graduate Students.

The GSA is mandated to ensure that ALL graduate students have comparable and continuous Canadian Health & Dental Benefits in place from September 1 – August 31 each year, whether through the Student VIP Medavie Blue Cross<sup>™</sup> plan or an alternate insurance provider.

### Are All Graduate Students Initially Charged The GSA Health & Dental Benefits Plan Fee?

Yes, all graduate students will see the GSA Health & Dental Benefits Plan fee and will be able to see this charge on their student finance (mybrock) account.




# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS...

Student VIP offers a wide variety of preferred providers near campus or home. To access the full network listing, please utilize our Provider Search Tool.

A "preferred provider" is a health care provider that is part of the Student VIP network that usually offers a discount for services or direct billing to the insurance company, so you do not have to pay the full cost out of pocket

#### What is the Brock GSA Health & Dental Benefits Plan?

The Brock GSA Health & Dental Plan is a comprehensive health and wellness benefits plan offered through **Student VIP** Medavie Blue Cross<sup>TM</sup> all for Brock University Graduate Students.

#### Why am I automatically enrolled the Brock GSA Health & Dental Benefits Plan?

The GSA is mandated to ensure that ALL graduate students have comparable and continuous Canadian Health & Dental Benefits in place from September 1 – August 31 each year, whether through the **Student VIP Medavie Blue Cross™** plan or an alternate insurance provider.

### Who is automatically assessed the Health & Dental Benefits Plan Fees?


All graduate students will be assessed the GSA Health & Dental Benefit Plan fee and will see this charge on their student finance (mybrock) account. The decision for all graduate students, part-time and full-time, to be initially assessed the fee was unanimously passed at the GSA's Annual General Meeting in April 2022.



### **UHIP PLAN VS GSA H&D PLAN**

### Is UHIP an eligible alternate substitute for the Brock GSA Health & Dental Benefits plan?

NO. UHIP (University Health Insurance Plan), which is administrated through the Brock International department, is the equivalent to OHIP (Ontario Health Insurance Plan), which covers Hospital visits, X-rays & Lab tests, Medical Doctor visits, etc. UHIP works in <u>PARTNERSHIP</u> with GSA Health & Dental Benefit plan to provide optimal insurance benefits while a graduate student at Brock University.
